INFINIS'S CORPORATE RESPONSIBILITY REPORT SHOWS COMPANY LEADING THE WAY IN SUSTAINABILITY

Infinis Limited, the UK's largest purely renewable energy generator, is pleased to announce the publication of its first interim corporate responsibility report for the first six months of 2007.

The report is a result of a review of the current policies and practices at Infinis as well as a high level benchmark set against the social and environmental approaches within the utilities and power generation sectors.

In order to assess environmental impact a carbon footprint assessment was undertaken by the Company in which Infinis was found to be carbon positive by over 4.8million tonnes of carbon dioxide equivalent (CO₂e)² for the period covered by the report. This demonstrates the invaluable contribution being made by Infinis's core activity of generating electricity from the potent greenhouse gases emitted by landfill sites, to reducing global warming.

Furthermore, Infinis has been working in conjunction with the National Energy Foundation in order to develop the "smallsteps" green benefits for Infinis employees. As set out within the interim report, a range of incentives have been adopted relating to individuals reducing their personal energy consumption in the following two areas:

- Company and personal cars – grants are available to encourage employees to select low emission vehicles
- Household energy consumption – grants and loans are available to make it easier for employees to install micro generation renewable energy projects in their homes

Alan Lovell, Chief Executive of Infinis Limited, commented:

"Sustainability forms the underlying bedrock of Infinis's business strategy. There are no greater environmental challenges facing society than responding to

climate change and we are in the frontline of that response with our focus on renewable energy.

We have endeavoured to produce a report which we believe sets an achievable standard of best practice for sustainable industries: from electricity generation to each individual employee's direct impact on the environment."
