Infinis ranked first in Sunday Times 2012 buyout growth league

Infinis, one of the UK's leading generators of renewable power, was recognised by the [Sunday Times](#) on 5 February as the fastest growing large buyout in the UK in the Sunday Times/Deloitte 2012 league.

The league, which looked at companies with profits over £50 million, ranked businesses by the growth that they had achieved over their last two financial years. In 2003, Infinis' generation capacity was 57MW; now it is 556MW, making it one of the UK's largest renewable generators.

Commenting on the announcement, Eric Machiels, Chief Executive of Infinis, said:

"It is great to get this kind of recognition especially given Infinis was the only renewable energy business in the league. Our close cooperation with shareholder Terra Firma since 2003 has seen Infinis expand significantly – meaning that we now generate about 10% of the UK's renewable energy. Our strategy is to continue this growth and play a leading role in this dynamic growth sector while positively contributing to carbon abatement in the UK."
